Submission Guidelines

- Abstract Submission Deadline = Sunday, December 15, 2019 11:59 p.m. no exceptions

 - This submission link will be deactivated after the submission deadline.
 - Abstracts submitted via email will not be accepted. For any technical issues upon submission, contact Tydal Jackson, CUSOM GME Coordinator, at tmjackson@campbell.edu.
 - Abstract <u>must</u> be submitted before the poster acceptance letters for the event will <u>only</u> be provided upon the submission of the abstract.
- Poster Submission Deadline = Friday, January 10, 2020, 11:59 p.m. no exceptions
 - o Submit poster as a PDF file to tmjackson@campbell.edu
 - Early poster submissions are strongly encouraged for early printing purposes. CUSOM will print all
 posters free of charge and hold them in a secure location until the night of the event.
- Poster Size Requirement = 36" x 48"

Participation Requirements

- 1. <u>Participation at a PGY-1 level for a case presentation is required</u>. Also, <u>participation of either a case or IRB</u> approved project or "work in progress" is required for the PGY 3+ terminal year of the program.
- 2. All sections of the Abstract Submission Form must be completed.
- 3. Poster must include a quality parameter (what you learned) and will be assigned to one of the 8 CMS categories.
- 4. Abstract and poster must include the attending physician mentor for the case/project.
- 5. The <u>primary author</u> for the case/project <u>must be a resident</u>.
- 6. Abstract and poster must include an osteopathic element related to either philosophy or treatment.
- 7. Groups cannot exceed the <u>maximum number of 5 participants</u> (including the required attending physician mentor and students where applicable). Not all members of the group need be present for the competition event in February.
